Aili Linnea Wainwright died in Green Bay on August 11, 2026. She was 81. Born in Green Bay on November 8, 1944, into a Finnish-American household that treated work as a language. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She tested pulp until numbers told the truth. A sample bottle rack by the sink was her garden; quality was a habit, not a slogan. Colleagues still mention a sample bottle rack by the sink.

She married Toivo in 1968. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two daughters through public schools and ordinary weather. After Toivo died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember someone who swept the sidewalk past the property line when weather had been unfair. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Green Bay, among streets she never needed to explain. The chair by the window still holds the shape of a habit.
