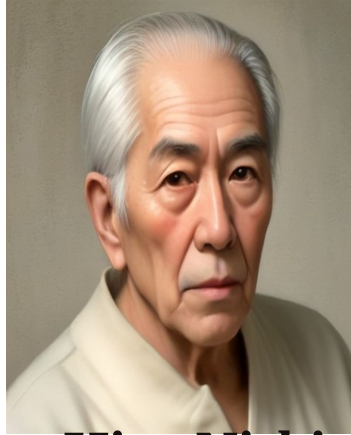




Akira Hiro Nishimura

November 22, 1938 - September 1, 2026

Manchester, New Hampshire

Akira Hiro Nishimura died in Manchester on September 1, 2026. He was 87. Born on November 22, 1938, with Japanese-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He fixed frames that fed a city. A toolbox with drawers labeled twice was his map; downtime offended him like a personal slight. Colleagues still mention a toolbox with drawers labeled twice.

He married Yuki in 1960. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two daughters through public schools and ordinary weather. After Yuki died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember coffee offered before questions. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Manchester, among streets he never needed to explain. The garden will come up next spring without being told.
