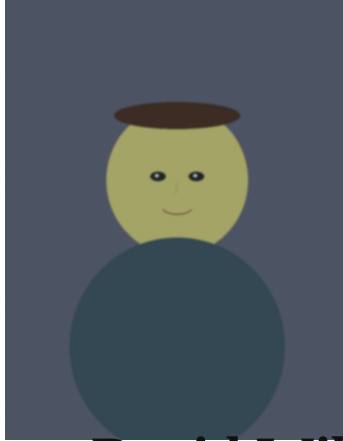




Albert David Wiberg

January 11, 1944 - September 5, 2026
Cleveland, Ohio

Albert David Wiberg died in Cleveland on September 5, 2026. He was 82. Born on January 11, 1944 and raised among Swedish-American manners that never needed a speech. He learned that neighborhoods remember who helps without being asked.

He ran cars that had to look rested for strangers before dawn. A cleaner cart checklist taught that made seats are small mercies. Colleagues still mention a cleaner cart checklist.

In 1970 he married Sharon. The marriage was not a speech; it was groceries, repairs, and three daughters walked to school in weather that did not care. When Sharon died in 2019, he kept what still worked: the early walk, the small garden, the call on Sundays.

Neighbors remember coffee offered before questions. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Cleveland, among streets he never needed to explain. The key is still under the same brick.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
