



Angela Rose Mancini

December 1, 1950 - August 31, 2026

Worcester, Massachusetts

Angela Rose Mancini died in Worcester on August 31, 2026. She was seventy-five. Born there on December 1, 1950, she grew up above a bakery her uncle still called the shop, and she learned a roll before she learned a campus. A tray, she believed, should arrive complete.

She spent twenty-six years behind that counter, then another decade running a church hall kitchen that fed whoever came after a funeral. She would not let a widow be rushed toward a sheet cake she had not chosen. She would not let a vendor invent a discount that made the register a liar. After a bad afternoon she sat in the car with the radio off until her hands were quiet.

She married Paul Mancini in 1972. They raised a daughter in a triple-decker that needed storm windows and a son who needed a ride to CYO at hours no one should be awake. Paul drove a bread truck. Angela packed lunches and considered a Sunday gravy a civic obligation. After he died in 2015 she kept the garden of tomatoes against the porch and the habit of sending a plate next door.

Friends remember a woman who showed up with soup as if that were the natural use of a Tuesday, who could explain a price without making it a sermon, and who kept one good coat. She loved a quiet gallery at the museum, a cup of coffee that was never quite hot enough, and the common when it looked like pewter. She died in Worcester, the brick city she refused to narrate as a punch line. The counter is closed. The fairness she practiced there is harder to replace than a recipe card.

Services
