



## Arturo Javier Beltran

*March 16, 1962 - September 1, 2026*

Riverside, California

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Arturo Javier Beltran died in Riverside on September 1, 2026. He was sixty-four. Born there on March 16, 1962, he grew up in a valley that still had groves at the edges and warehouses in the middle. He learned English at school and a second set of manners at the table. He never treated either language as a costume.

He spent twenty-one years in a distribution warehouse that fed stores before daylight, first as a helper, later as the man who could hear a tired conveyor before the logbook admitted it. He did not advertise. Managers called him because he would scrap a pallet even when the truck was already promised. He kept extra water for the clerk whose morning had already been too long. He charged a fair hour on the side when a church supper needed more mercy than a price list.

He married Anita Beltran in 1986. They raised a son and a daughter in a bungalow that needed a new roof more often than the budget admitted. Anita taught school. Arturo packed lunches that could survive heat. After a bad afternoon he sat in the car with the radio off until his hands were quiet.

Friends remember a man who brought extra bread to a night shift without staying for thanks, who knew which intern needed a second explanation, and who hummed while he worked as if the belt were a conversation. He loved a late-summer orange, a clean map of the rack, and the particular quiet after the last pallet. He died in Riverside, in the heat he had always preferred to a clean cold. The warehouse still opens. Someone else will count the racks.
