Friends in Duluth remember Beatrice Joy Miller, who died on September 2, 2026 at 91. Born on October 4, 1934, with Lebanese-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She grew up believing that showing up was the first craft.

She fried mornings into boxes that left before travelers woke fully. A route tray tag never smeared taught that small mercies matter. Colleagues still mention a route tray tag never smeared.

In 1957 she married Edward. The marriage was not a speech; it was groceries, repairs, and a daughter and two sons walked to school in weather that did not care. When Edward died in 2019, she kept what still worked: the early walk, the small garden, the call on Sundays.

Neighbors remember someone who knew every child's name on the block. She preferred the hour before a town fully wakes. Duluth was home enough that she never rehearsed an introduction. The garden will come up next spring without being told.

Services

Services in Duluth will be simple: stories, coffee, and the names of people who showed up. Flowers optional; support for a local clinic or trade scholarship preferred.

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
