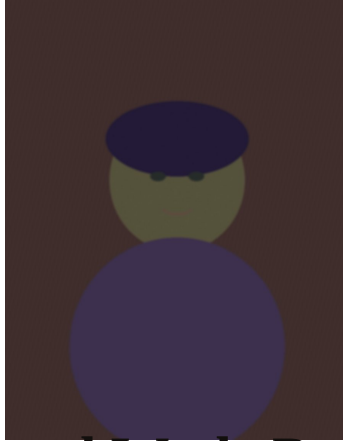




Bernard Wade Peachey

July 15, 1942 - September 15, 2026

Evansville, Indiana

Evansville lost Bernard Wade Peachey on September 15, 2026. He was 84. Born on July 15, 1942, with Puerto Rican roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned that neighborhoods remember who helps without being asked.

He routed cabs through nights that would not wait for excuses. A night dispatch radio mic cover survived winters that ruined lesser gear. Colleagues still mention a night dispatch radio mic cover.

He and Grace married in 1966 and raised two children without needing an audience. After Grace's death in 2019, he held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember covered dishes that arrived without a speech. He preferred the hour before a town fully wakes. Evansville was home enough that he never rehearsed an introduction. The tools are still hung where a hand can find them in the dark.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
