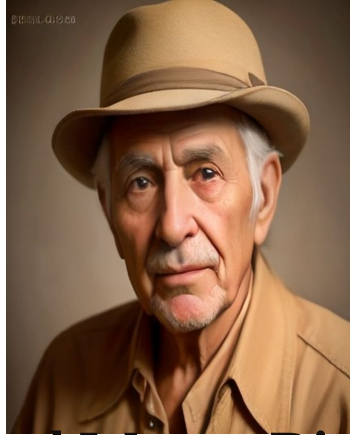




Bernard Wayne Dimitriou

January 10, 1934 - August 20, 2026

Huntington, West Virginia

Bernard Wayne Dimitriou, 92, of Huntington, died on August 20, 2026. Born on January 10, 1934 and raised among Greek-American manners that never needed a speech. He learned that neighborhoods remember who helps without being asked.

He settled claims without settling for blame. A claim form stamp ended arguments more gently than lawyers. Colleagues still mention a claim form stamp.

He married Sandra in 1959. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Sandra died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Huntington, among streets he never needed to explain. The chair by the window still holds the shape of a habit.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
