April 6, 1937 - August 8, 2026

Anchorage, Alaska

Betty Sue Quijano died in Anchorage on August 8, 2026. She was 89. Born on April 6, 1937, with Mexican-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She learned that neighborhoods remember who helps without being asked.

She stamped crates that had to clear before heat ruined a season. A produce stamp pad dried overnight meant tomorrow would not invent grades. Colleagues still mention a produce stamp pad dried overnight.

She married William in 1959. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised three sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After William died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember someone who swept the sidewalk past the property line when weather had been unfair. Mornings were her favorite shift at home. She died in Anchorage, on streets that already knew her pace. The tools are still hung where a hand can find them in the dark.
