



Beulah Mae Larsson

December 18, 1942 - September 4, 2026

Billings, Montana

Beulah Mae Larsson died in Billings on September 4, 2026. She was 83. Born on December 18, 1942, with Swedish-Cherokee roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She greeted patients by name and kinship when forms failed. A beaded lanyard held her badge; she translated bureaucracy into care. Colleagues still mention a beaded lanyard for her badge.

She married Earl in 1964. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Earl died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember coffee offered before questions. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Billings, among streets she never needed to explain. The key is still under the same brick.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
