



Beulah Mae Yarborough

December 1, 1942 - September 3, 2026

Billings, Montana

Beulah Mae Yarborough died in Billings on September 3, 2026. She was 83. Born in Billings on December 1, 1942, with Cherokee roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She greeted patients by name and kinship when forms failed. A beaded lanyard held her badge; she translated bureaucracy into care. Colleagues still mention a beaded lanyard for her badge.

She married Earl in 1968. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Earl died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Billings, among streets she never needed to explain. The porch still expects a returning step.
