



## Camila Rosa Nogueira

*February 16, 1951 - September 1, 2026*

Fayetteville, Arkansas

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Camila Rosa Nogueira died in Fayetteville on September 1, 2026. She was 75. Born in Fayetteville on February 16, 1951, with Brazilian-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She fielded parents, principals, and lost lunch money with the same calm. A drawer of hall passes held kindness; children learned her desk was safe. Colleagues still mention a drawer of hall passes and kindness.

She married Mateo in 1978. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two daughters through public schools and ordinary weather. After Mateo died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a porch light left on for anyone walking home late. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Fayetteville, among streets she never needed to explain. The chair by the window still holds the shape of a habit.
