May 11, 1954 - August 19, 2026

Tampa, Florida

Carmen Lucia Rojas died in Tampa on August 19, 2026. She was 72. Born in Tampa on May 11, 1954, raised among Colombian-American manners that never needed a speech. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She ran floors that never slept. A checklist in two languages kept standards; she taught that a made bed is a small mercy. Colleagues still mention a cart checklist in two languages.

She married Diego in 1977. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Diego died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a rake leaned against a shared fence after a storm. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Tampa, among streets she never needed to explain. The tools are still hung where a hand can find them in the dark.
