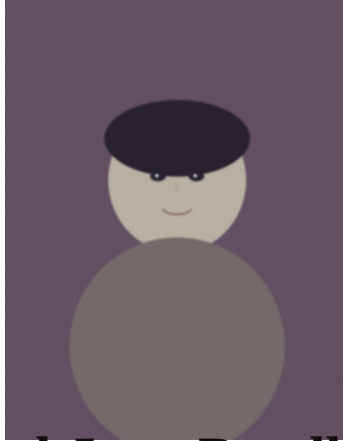




Carol Jean Pendleton

Carol Jean Pendleton, 69, of Marquette, died on September 15, 2026. Born in Marquette on April 25, 1957; English-American cooking and payday thrift set the tone of the house. Early on, she decided that a paycheck and a handshake should weigh the same.

She matched colors that had to look inevitable on the rack. A dye-lot card yellowed but legible outlasted three managers. Colleagues still mention a dye-lot card yellowed but legible.

She and Charles married in 1984 and raised three sons without needing an audience. After Charles's death in 2019, she held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember snow shoveled past the corner that was not required. She preferred the hour before a town fully wakes. Marquette was home enough that she never rehearsed an introduction. The radio is still tuned to the station that played while work got done.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
