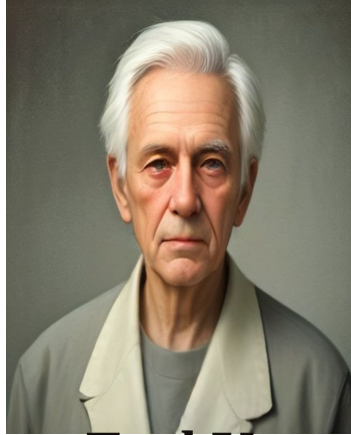




Clarence Earl Kravchenko

September 22, 1957 - August 6, 2026

Bismarck, North Dakota

Clarence Earl Kravchenko, 68, of Bismarck, died on August 6, 2026. Born in Bismarck on September 22, 1957; Ukrainian-American cooking and payday thrift set the tone of the house. From the start, he treated promises like tools: keep them sharp, do not lend them lightly.

He calibrated gauges that kept plants from guessing. A calibration sticker book was gospel in small print. Colleagues still mention a calibration sticker book.

He married Susan in 1982. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised four children through public schools and ordinary weather. After Susan died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember the radio low on a Saturday while repairs got done. Mornings were his favorite shift at home. He died in Bismarck, on streets that already knew his pace. The garden will come up next spring without being told.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
