



Clarence Ray Satterthwaite

July 11, 1932 - September 9, 2026

Tucson, Arizona

Tucson lost Clarence Ray Satterthwaite on September 9, 2026. He was 94. Born in Tucson on July 11, 1932, into a Irish-American household that treated work as a language. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He made change for strangers before dawn with equal courtesy. A token booth change tray wiped nightly was honesty you could hold. Colleagues still mention a token booth change tray wiped nightly.

He married Margaret in 1954. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Margaret died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. He preferred the hour before a town fully wakes. Tucson was home enough that he never rehearsed an introduction. The porch still expects a returning step.
