



Claude Etienne Moreau

May 26, 1942 - August 16, 2026

Macon, Georgia

Claude Etienne Moreau died in Macon on August 16, 2026. He was 84. Born in Macon on May 26, 1942, raised among Franco-American manners that never needed a speech. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He heard a bad loom the way a musician hears a wrong note. An oilcan with a bent spout fixed more than machines; it fixed paychecks. Colleagues still mention an oilcan with a bent spout.

He married Colette in 1968. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Colette died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Macon, among streets he never needed to explain. The key is still under the same brick.
