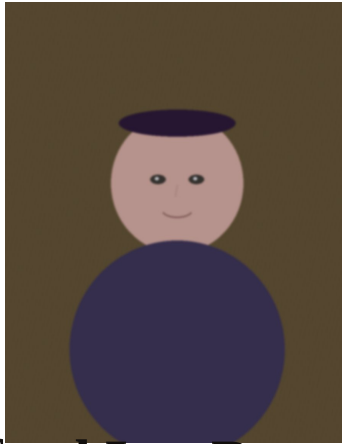




Clifford Lee Duvernois

January 25, 1936 - August 31, 2026

Green Bay, Wisconsin

Clifford Lee Duvernois died in Green Bay on August 31, 2026. He was 90. Born January 25, 1936 in Green Bay, carrying French-American stories that arrived without footnotes. From the start, he treated promises like tools: keep them sharp, do not lend them lightly.

He issued patterns that kept pours from improvising danger. A pattern bin labeled twice outlasted three managers. Colleagues still mention a pattern bin labeled twice.

In 1962 he married Barbara. The marriage was not a speech; it was groceries, repairs, and one son and three daughters walked to school in weather that did not care. When Barbara died in 2019, he kept what still worked: the early walk, the small garden, the call on Sundays.

Neighbors remember coffee offered before questions. Mornings were his favorite shift at home. He died in Green Bay, on streets that already knew his pace. The garden will come up next spring without being told.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
