



Consuelo Paz Ybarra

October 3, 1950 - August 26, 2026

Boise, Idaho

Consuelo Paz Ybarra died in Boise on August 26, 2026. She was 75. Born on October 3, 1950, with Mexican-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She ran a line that never forgave a slow morning. Her whistle meant shift change and fairness; she made sure piece rates did not erase dignity. Colleagues still mention a whistle on a string for shift changes.

She married Miguel in 1974. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Miguel died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember someone who swept the sidewalk past the property line when weather had been unfair. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Boise, among streets she never needed to explain. The tools are still hung where a hand can find them in the dark.
