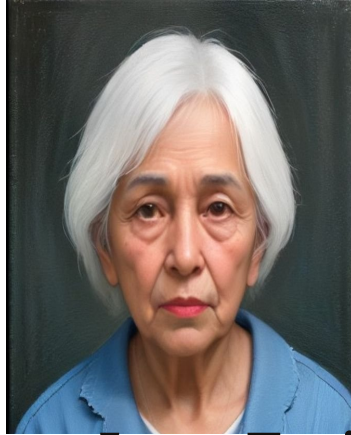




Dolores Irene Espinoza

July 3, 1954 - August 13, 2026

Reno, Nevada

Dolores Irene Espinoza died in Reno on August 13, 2026. She was 72. Born on July 3, 1954, raised among Mexican-American manners that never needed a speech. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She ran carts through nights that never ended. A red lanyard key meant trust; she taught that clean rooms are a kind of respect. Colleagues still mention a cart key on a red lanyard.

She married Rafael in 1980. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Rafael died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember coffee offered before questions. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Reno, among streets she never needed to explain. The recipe card is still stained in the useful places.

Services

A memorial gathering in Reno with coffee afterward. In lieu of flowers, a gift to a local workers' fund, clinic, or neighborhood library is welcome.
