



# Doris Faye Haverford

*October 4, 1935 - July 19, 2026*

Family and neighbors in Mobile mark the death of Doris Faye Haverford on July 19, 2026. She was 90. Born on October 4, 1935 and raised among Austrian-American manners that never needed a speech. Young, she understood that quiet competence outlasts loud plans.

She ran nights when the terminal felt like another country. A produce cooler clipboard kept tempo without cruelty. Colleagues still mention a produce cooler clipboard.

She and Donald married in 1962 and raised two daughters and a son without needing an audience. After Donald's death in 2019, she held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember a rake leaned against a shared fence after a storm. Mornings were her favorite shift at home. She died in Mobile, on streets that already knew her pace. The extra coffee is still in the thermos.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
