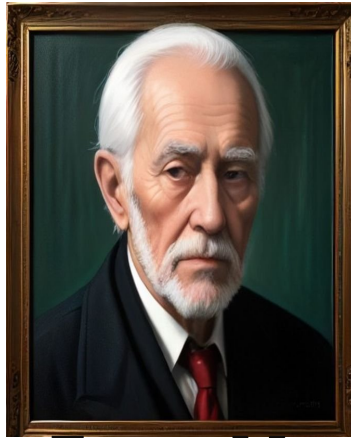




Duncan Fraser MacGregor

October 11, 1946 - August 30, 2026

Tulsa, Oklahoma

Duncan Fraser MacGregor died in Tulsa on August 30, 2026. He was 79. Born on October 11, 1946, into a Scotch-Irish household that treated work as a language. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He fitted pipe in heat that taught humility. Wrenches hung by length; leaks were personal insults. Colleagues still mention a pipe wrench hung by length.

He married Margaret in 1968. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Margaret died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Tulsa, among streets he never needed to explain. The garden will come up next spring without being told.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
