October 16, 1933 - July 11, 2026

Little Rock, Arkansas

Edna Kay Niedzwiadek, 92, of Little Rock, died on July 11, 2026. Born October 16, 1933 in Little Rock, carrying Italian-American stories that arrived without footnotes. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She milked mornings into readiness before the first truck arrived. A milking stool tagged with initials outlasted three barns. Colleagues still mention a milking stool tagged with initials.

She and John married in 1960 and raised two daughters and a son without needing an audience. After John's death in 2019, she held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember snow shoveled past the corner that was not required. Mornings were her favorite shift at home. She died in Little Rock, on streets that already knew her pace. The work gloves still keep the shape of a grip.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
