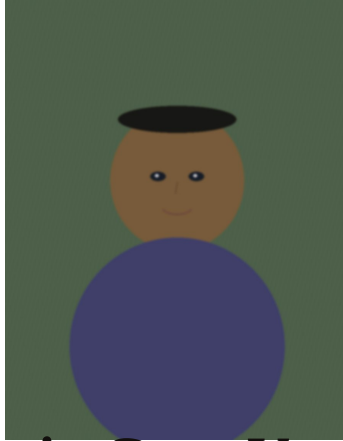




Edwin Gene Varelas

January 5, 1956 - August 3, 2026

Burlington, Vermont

Burlington lost Edwin Gene Varelas on August 3, 2026. He was 70. Born in Burlington on January 5, 1956, into a Mexican-American household that treated work as a language. From the start, he treated promises like tools: keep them sharp, do not lend them lightly.

He moved chile and crews without confusing either for the other. A chile roast rake stayed clean enough to trust. Colleagues still mention a chile roast rake.

He married Linda in 1978. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised four children through public schools and ordinary weather. After Linda died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. Mornings were his favorite shift at home. He died in Burlington, on streets that already knew his pace. The calendar still has a circle on payday.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
