Edwin Neal Hennessey of Pueblo died on June 1, 2026 at the age of 93. Born in Pueblo on January 1, 1933; Egyptian-American cooking and payday thrift set the tone of the house. He learned that neighborhoods remember who helps without being asked.

He baled trees that had to look inevitable on lots. A baler twine knife sheath outlasted two seasons of hurry. Colleagues still mention a baler twine knife sheath.

In 1959 he married Alice. The marriage was not a speech; it was groceries, repairs, and two sons walked to school in weather that did not care. When Alice died in 2019, he kept what still worked: the early walk, the small garden, the call on Sundays.

Neighbors remember a jumper cable offered before the tow truck was dialed. He preferred the hour before a town fully wakes. Pueblo was home enough that he never rehearsed an introduction. The calendar still has a circle on payday.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
