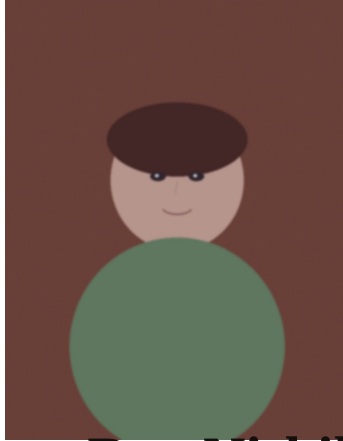




Eugene Ray Nishikawa

January 21, 1940 - August 29, 2026
Sacramento, California

Friends in Sacramento remember Eugene Ray Nishikawa, who died on August 29, 2026 at 86. Born in Sacramento on January 21, 1940; Japanese-American cooking and payday thrift set the tone of the house. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She kept chairs moving through weather that made tourists invent bravery. A lift-pass punch with a chipped handle outlasted three seasons of hurry. Colleagues still mention a lift-pass punch with a chipped handle.

He and Dorothy married in 1967 and raised four children without needing an audience. After Dorothy's death in 2019, he held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember snow shoveled past the corner that was not required. Mornings were his favorite shift at home. He died in Sacramento, on streets that already knew his pace. The chair by the window still holds the shape of a habit.
