



Eula Mae Riverson

November 30, 1935 - August 14, 2026

Charleston, South Carolina

Eula Mae Riverson died in Charleston on August 14, 2026. She was 90. Born on November 30, 1935, with Gullah Geechee coast roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She graded leaf with hands that knew seasons. A soft grading glove outlasted fashion; buyers trusted her eye more than moisture meters. Colleagues still mention a grading glove soft as cloth.

She married Isaiah in 1959. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised three children through public schools and ordinary weather. After Isaiah died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember someone who swept the sidewalk past the property line when weather had been unfair. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Charleston, among streets she never needed to explain. The chair by the window still holds the shape of a habit.
