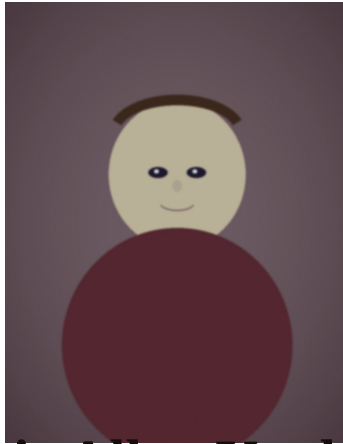




Francis Allen Krukowski

July 23, 1940 - August 25, 2026

Savannah, Georgia

Savannah lost Francis Allen Krukowski on August 25, 2026. He was 86. Born July 23, 1940 in Savannah, carrying Czech-American stories that arrived without footnotes. He learned that neighborhoods remember who helps without being asked.

He issued lamps that kept men from improvising darkness. A lamp-house inventory card was gospel in small print. Colleagues still mention a lamp-house inventory card.

In 1966 he married Evelyn. The marriage was not a speech; it was groceries, repairs, and a son and a daughter walked to school in weather that did not care. When Evelyn died in 2019, he kept what still worked: the early walk, the small garden, the call on Sundays.

Neighbors remember a jumper cable offered before the tow truck was dialed. He preferred the hour before a town fully wakes. Savannah was home enough that he never rehearsed an introduction. The calendar still has a circle on payday.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
