Monaco, undefined

Grace Kelly - Academy Award-winning American actress and, as Princess Grace, consort of Prince Rainier III of Monaco - died in Monaco on September 14, 1982, of injuries from a automobile crash on a mountain road the day before. She was fifty-two. Her daughter Stephanie survived the wreck; the world that had watched a Philadelphia bricklayer's granddaughter become Hitchcock's cool blonde and then a European princess mourned in two languages at once.

Born in Philadelphia on November 12, 1929, she trained for the stage, found film work that sharpened into *High Noon*, *Dial M for Murder*, *Rear Window*, *To Catch a Thief*, and *The Country Girl* - the last bringing the Oscar. The 1956 wedding in Monaco ended a Hollywood career at its peak and began a different public life of state visits, charities, and the careful privacy of a small principality under a large spotlight.

She never quite stopped being American in the public imagination: East Falls roots, crisp consonants, a screen stillness that directors used like glass. After the crash, hospitals and bulletins filled the same wires that had once carried premiere gossip. Rainier and their children buried a woman who had made glamour look like discipline.

She died in Monaco on September 14, 1982. Philadelphia still claims the girl; Monaco keeps the princess; the films keep the craft.

Kelly's screen work rewards rewatching less for costume than for timing - the pause before a glance, the refusal to overplay panic. Royal life asked for a different performance and she gave it without apology. Notice Nearby records an American death date on a foreign road, because the calendar of September 14 already knows how

often glamour and gravity share a headline.

Services

Died in Monaco on September 14, 1982, following a car crash on September 13. American actress and Princess of Monaco; buried at the Cathedral of Our Lady Immaculate, Monaco.
