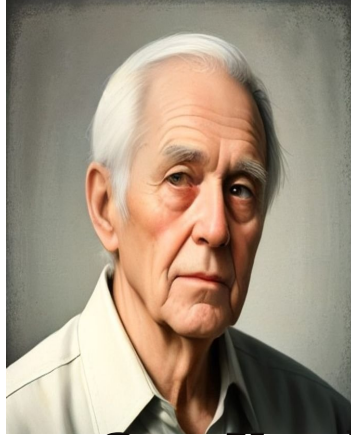




Hans Otto Xander

April 9, 1945 - August 21, 2026

Lincoln, Nebraska

Hans Otto Xander died in Lincoln on August 21, 2026. He was 81. Born on April 9, 1945, with German-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He kept a line moving without treating people as parts. A stopwatch lived in his pocket unused; fairness was the real tempo. Colleagues still mention a stopwatch he never needed to wind.

He married Greta in 1967. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Greta died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Lincoln, among streets he never needed to explain. The recipe card is still stained in the useful places.
