



Hans Otto Zeidler

April 9, 1946 - August 20, 2026

Omaha, Nebraska

Hans Otto Zeidler died in Omaha on August 20, 2026. He was 80. Born on April 9, 1946, with German-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He kept a line moving without treating people as parts. A stopwatch lived in his pocket unused; fairness was the real tempo. Colleagues still mention a stopwatch he never needed to wind.

He married Greta in 1971. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Greta died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a rake leaned against a shared fence after a storm. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Omaha, among streets he never needed to explain. The tools are still hung where a hand can find them in the dark.
