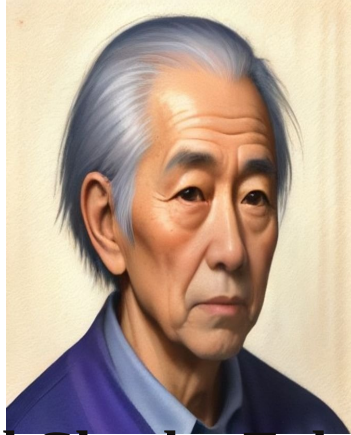




Harold Charles Fukushima

May 16, 1946 - August 24, 2026

Utica, New York

Harold Charles Fukushima, 80, of Utica, died on August 24, 2026. Born in Utica on May 16, 1946; Japanese-American cooking and payday thrift set the tone of the house. He learned that neighborhoods remember who helps without being asked.

He named damage without naming people as careless. An estimate clipboard with frank notes rebuilt more than cars. Colleagues still mention an estimate clipboard with frank notes.

He married Diane in 1971. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Diane died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a porch light left on for anyone walking home late. Mornings were his favorite shift at home. He died in Utica, on streets that already knew his pace. The tools are still hung where a hand can find them in the dark.

Services

A memorial gathering in Utica with coffee afterward. In lieu of flowers, a gift to a local workers' fund, clinic, or neighborhood library is welcome.
