March 4, 1938 - August 9, 2026

Juneau, Alaska

Family and neighbors in Juneau mark the death of Helen Jane Yegorova on August 9, 2026. She was 88. Born on March 4, 1938 and raised among Russian-American manners that never needed a speech. From the start, she treated promises like tools: keep them sharp, do not lend them lightly.

She kept bush pilots honest about weather and weight. A flight clipboard with clipped corners was her map of who would make it home. Colleagues still mention a flight clipboard with clipped corners.

She and James married in 1965 and raised three sons without needing an audience. After James's death in 2019, she held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. Mornings were her favorite shift at home. She died in Juneau, on streets that already knew her pace. The extra coffee is still in the thermos.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
