Helen Joyce Montclair died in Pueblo on August 18, 2026. She was 85. Born on January 15, 1941, raised among African American manners that never needed a speech. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She fed mill crews from a steam table that never got a holiday. A cast-iron skillet she never lent was half myth and half thrift. Colleagues still mention a cast-iron skillet she never lent.

She married Raymond in 1963. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Raymond died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Pueblo, among streets she never needed to explain. The key is still under the same brick.
