



Henry James Pacheco

August 6, 1944 - August 21, 2026

Casper, Wyoming

Henry James Pacheco died in Casper on August 21, 2026. He was 82. Born in Casper on August 6, 1944, with Mexican-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He moved freight on paper before it moved on steel. A timetable pencil stub outlasted computers; he filed delays without blaming the weather out loud. Colleagues still mention a timetable pencil stub.

He married Dorothy in 1971. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Dorothy died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a rake leaned against a shared fence after a storm. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Casper, among streets he never needed to explain. The extra coffee is still in the thermos.
