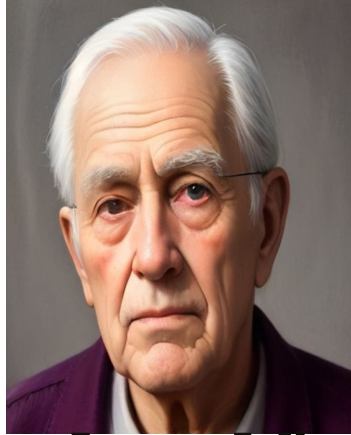




Henry James Winthrop

August 7, 1944 - August 22, 2026

Casper, Wyoming

Henry James Winthrop died in Casper on August 22, 2026. He was 82. Born in Casper on August 7, 1944, raised among Anglo West manners that never needed a speech. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He moved freight on paper before it moved on steel. A timetable pencil stub outlasted computers; he filed delays without blaming the weather out loud. Colleagues still mention a timetable pencil stub.

He married Dorothy in 1967. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Dorothy died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Casper, among streets he never needed to explain. The chair by the window still holds the shape of a habit.
