Herbert Earl Radziewicz, 78, of Shreveport, died on July 19, 2026. Born on July 7, 1948, with Vietnamese-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. Young, he understood that quiet competence outlasts loud plans.

He watched charts that turned milk into something shelves could trust. A pasteurizer chart pencil lived in his shirt pocket like a conscience. Colleagues still mention a pasteurizer chart pencil.

In 1971 he married Patricia. The marriage was not a speech; it was groceries, repairs, and a son and a daughter walked to school in weather that did not care. When Patricia died in 2019, he kept what still worked: the early walk, the small garden, the call on Sundays.

Neighbors remember someone who knew every child's name on the block. He preferred the hour before a town fully wakes. Shreveport was home enough that he never rehearsed an introduction. The key is still under the same brick.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
