



Ignacio Felipe Montoya

April 2, 1956 - August 28, 2026

Carson City, Nevada

Ignacio Felipe Montoya died in Carson City on August 28, 2026. He was seventy. Born there on April 2, 1956, he grew up in a capital that still had print shops at the edges and a dome in the middle. He learned English at school and a second set of manners at the table. He never treated either language as a costume.

He spent twenty-two years in the state print shop, first as a helper washing ink from pans that never quite came clean, later as the man who could hear a tired press before the logbook admitted it. He was the adult who could sit with a form without making a production of it. He kept extra paper in a drawer for the clerk whose morning had already been too long. When a bill came down in a hurry he printed it twice: once for the record, and once for the quiet that says you are not in trouble for needing a copy.

He married Teresa Montoya in 1979. They bought a bungalow in a neighborhood that later became expensive around them. They stayed. A son and a daughter went through public schools he trusted more than he trusted real-estate talk. After Teresa died in 2020 he kept the garden of peppers and the habit of walking a neighbor's child to the bus when a shift ran late.

Neighbors remember a man who swept his sidewalk and yours if the wind had been unfair, who kept a coffee can of leading labeled in two languages, and who could sit through a graduation without making it about himself. He liked the river early, before the heat, when the trees still looked like a place a person could walk. He died in Carson City, the only town he had ever needed. The extra paper is still in the drawer. That would have pleased him more than a eulogy.
