



Imogene Fay Crockette

April 4, 1942 - August 19, 2026

Chattanooga, Tennessee

Imogene Fay Crockette died in Chattanooga on August 19, 2026. She was 84. Born in Chattanooga on April 4, 1942, into a Southern Appalachian household that treated work as a language. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She matched colors under lights that lied. A stained chip book was her bible; she could recreate a customer's memory of blue. Colleagues still mention a color chip book stained at the edges.

She married Roy in 1967. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Roy died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Chattanooga, among streets she never needed to explain. The recipe card is still stained in the useful places.
