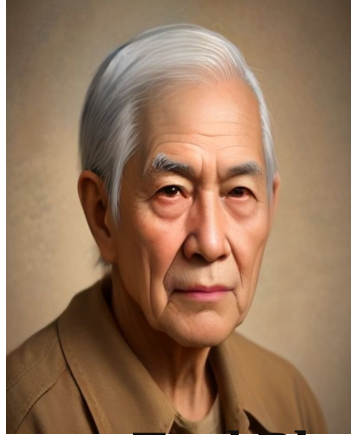




James Earl Pham

November 8, 1943 - August 30, 2026

Greenville, South Carolina

James Earl Pham died in Greenville on August 30, 2026. He was 82. Born in Greenville on November 8, 1943, with Vietnamese-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He graded leaf with hands that knew seasons. A soft grading glove outlasted fashion; buyers trusted his eye more than moisture meters. Colleagues still mention a grading glove soft as cloth.

He married Eula in 1967. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised three children through public schools and ordinary weather. After Eula died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember coffee offered before questions. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Greenville, among streets he never needed to explain. The garden will come up next spring without being told.
