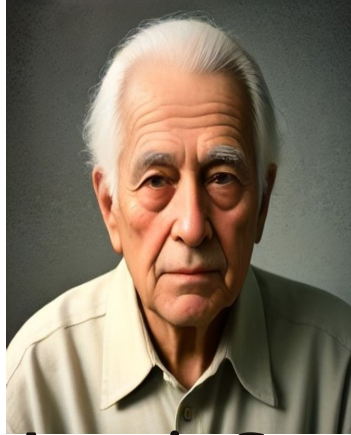




Jorge Antonio Castellanos

February 14, 1945 - September 6, 2026

Portland, Maine

Jorge Antonio Castellanos died in Portland on September 6, 2026. He was 81. Born in Portland on February 14, 1945, with Guatemalan-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He ran a line that never forgave a slow morning. A hairnet washed every night was pride; piece rates never erased dignity. Colleagues still mention a hairnet washed every night as pride.

He married Isabel in 1972. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Isabel died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a rake leaned against a shared fence after a storm. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Portland, among streets he never needed to explain. The chair by the window still holds the shape of a habit.
