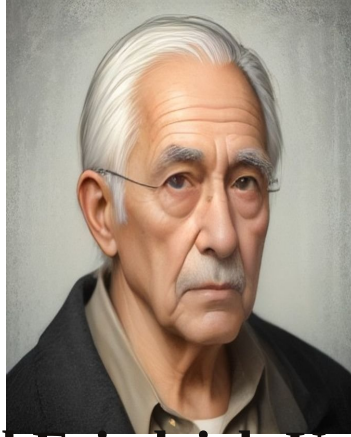




Karl Friedrich Urbina

May 2, 1944 - September 5, 2026

Youngstown, Ohio

Karl Friedrich Urbina died in Youngstown on September 5, 2026. He was 82. Born on May 2, 1944, with German-Latino roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He moved steel through air as if gravity were a suggestion. A thermos that never leaked outlasted three lunchboxes. Colleagues still mention a lunchbox thermos that never leaked.

He married Anna in 1966. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised three children through public schools and ordinary weather. After Anna died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Youngstown, among streets he never needed to explain. The extra coffee is still in the thermos.
