November 3, 1946 - August 9, 2026

Little Rock, Arkansas

Keiko Ann Yoshida died in Little Rock on August 9, 2026. She was 79. Born in Little Rock on November 3, 1946, with Japanese-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She counted, labeled, and double-checked with a care that kept wards safe. A pill-count tray polished smooth was her quiet instrument. Colleagues still mention a pill-count tray polished smooth.

She married Hiroshi in 1970. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Hiroshi died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Little Rock, among streets she never needed to explain. The porch still expects a returning step.
