



Klaus Otto Obermiller

September 22, 1949 - August 23, 2026

Worcester, Massachusetts

Klaus Otto Obermiller died in Worcester on August 23, 2026. He was 76. Born in Worcester on September 22, 1949, with German-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He heard a bad loom the way a musician hears a wrong note. An oilcan with a bent spout fixed more than machines; it fixed paychecks. Colleagues still mention an oilcan with a bent spout.

He married Ingrid in 1972. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son through public schools and ordinary weather. After Ingrid died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Worcester, among streets he never needed to explain. The recipe card is still stained in the useful places.
