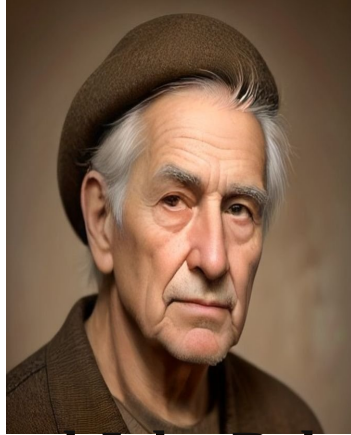




Leonard John Delvecchio

May 7, 1954 - August 26, 2026

Erie, Pennsylvania

Erie lost Leonard John Delvecchio on August 26, 2026. He was 72. Born on May 7, 1954, with Italian-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He called grades that decided seasons for barns. A tobacco grade tag spool rode his belt like a badge. Colleagues still mention a tobacco grade tag spool.

He and Janet married in 1978 and raised two sons without needing an audience. After Janet's death in 2019, he held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember a shovel borrowed and returned sharper. Mornings were his favorite shift at home. He died in Erie, on streets that already knew his pace. The Sunday call still has a time slot in the house.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
