



Lester Paul Onderdonk

January 13, 1943 - July 11, 2026

Tulsa, Oklahoma

Tulsa lost Lester Paul Onderdonk on July 11, 2026. He was 83. Born on January 13, 1943 and raised among Guamanian-American manners that never needed a speech. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He tended leers until sand became something windows could trust. A leer temperature chalk in plastic outlasted three shifts of hurry. Colleagues still mention a leer temperature chalk.

In 1969 he married Nancy. The marriage was not a speech; it was groceries, repairs, and three sons walked to school in weather that did not care. When Nancy died in 2019, he kept what still worked: the early walk, the small garden, the call on Sundays.

Neighbors remember a jumper cable offered before the tow truck was dialed. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Tulsa, among streets he never needed to explain. The work gloves still keep the shape of a grip.
