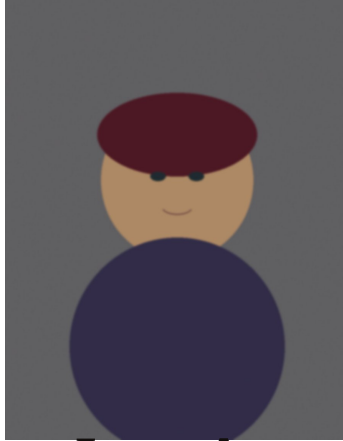




Lillian June Arceneaux

April 6, 1940 - June 12, 2026

Concord, New Hampshire

On June 12, 2026, Lillian June Arceneaux died at home in Concord. She was 86. Born on April 6, 1940, with African-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. Young, she understood that quiet competence outlasts loud plans.

She stretched walks across weather that did not care about property lines. A right-of-way flag pouch marked what the crew had already decided. Colleagues still mention a right-of-way flag pouch.

She married Albert in 1962. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised four children through public schools and ordinary weather. After Albert died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember someone who swept the sidewalk past the property line when weather had been unfair. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Concord, among streets she never needed to explain. The lunch pail still waits by the back door.
