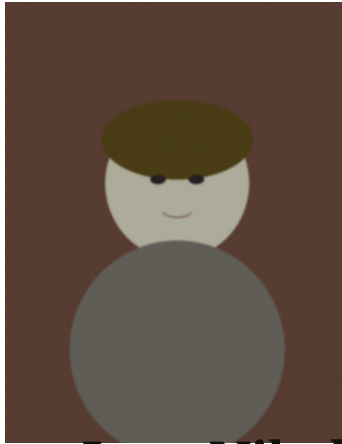




# Lillian June Nikolaidis

*October 16, 1936 - September 6, 2026*

Pensacola, Florida

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Lillian June Nikolaidis, 89, of Pensacola, died on September 6, 2026. Born on October 16, 1936, with Russian-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She grew up believing that showing up was the first craft.

She worked trams through darkness that made its own schedule. A tram whistle key by the locker stayed clean enough to trust. Colleagues still mention a tram whistle key by the locker.

In 1959 she married Albert. The marriage was not a speech; it was groceries, repairs, and two daughters and a son walked to school in weather that did not care. When Albert died in 2019, she kept what still worked: the early walk, the small garden, the call on Sundays.

Neighbors remember someone who knew every child's name on the block. Mornings were her favorite shift at home. She died in Pensacola, on streets that already knew her pace. The porch still expects a returning step.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
