Hilo lost Lois Nell Woolverton on September 5, 2026. She was 84. Born on October 28, 1941, with Hungarian-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. Young, she understood that quiet competence outlasts loud plans.

She bagged flour until numbers told the truth about barns. A flour bag stitch needle case lived in her apron forever. Colleagues still mention a flour bag stitch needle case.

She married Donald in 1963. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two daughters and a son through public schools and ordinary weather. After Donald died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. Mornings were her favorite shift at home. She died in Hilo, on streets that already knew her pace. The radio is still tuned to the station that played while work got done.
