Luz Maria Mansour died in Buffalo on September 9, 2026. She was 71. Born in Buffalo on October 29, 1954, into a Lebanese-Mexican household that treated work as a language. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She drove routes that were also neighborhoods. A transfer punch worn smooth marked years; riders knew her by the way she waited for the elderly. Colleagues still mention a transfer punch worn smooth.

She married Carlos in 1981. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two daughters through public schools and ordinary weather. After Carlos died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Buffalo, among streets she never needed to explain. The radio is still tuned to the station that played while work got done.
